

RULES FOR TOP CLUB [amended Nov. 2013]

1. All games will be played under EBA rules.
2. Matches to be played on a home and away basis, with the overall result counting as the result. 2 points for a win and 1 for a draw on each rink. Should there be a tie at the end of the games, (home and away), then the shot difference of all games played would then come into account.

In the event of there still being a tie on points and shots, after the second game then the TRIPLE will play an extra end.

3. In the case of the final ALL rinks must play to a result e.g. rinks with an equal score must play an extra end.
4. Matches will consist of :-

1Triple

1Pair

1 Singles -2-wood 21 ends

1 singles -4-wood 21 shots

5. The first round to be played both home and away by end of June.

Semi-finals by end of August and the final no later than 2nd week in September on a neutral green, approx half way between participating clubs

- 6 All score cards to be forwarded immediately to the secretary of host club for that season.

{There are no rules shown in World Bowls regarding a team being short of a player except in case of 'fours', so presumably clubs could come to arrangement on this by 'giving up' one of the disciplines thereby benefitting opponents .}
